Women Win is searching for a research consultant to explore digital data collection applications that can be used by local implementing partners delivering the Goal programme.

Women Win

Women Win is a global multi-dimensional women's fund guided by the vision of a future where every girl and woman exercises her rights. Our work is done through investing in and supporting a diverse global portfolio of re-grantees (including non-traditional actors); providing technical support and advisory services; influencing a wide range of stakeholders and brokering unusual partnerships; creating strategic alliances with other women's funds; and co-creating collective funds based on shared governance. Women Win advances girls' and women's rights amidst the scarce resources that are available for the feminist movement. We achieve our vision throughout two main areas of work: girl's rights through sport and play, and women's economic resilience.

Through GRLS, Women Win advances the playing field that empowers adolescent girls and young women to exercise their rights through sport and play.

Goal Programme

GRLS has partnered with Futuremakers by Standard Chartered to help deliver and advance the Goal education programme. The Goal programme uses sport, play and life-skills education to help tackle inequity and promote economic inclusion among girls ages 12-18 who live in underserved communities. Goal participants learn the skills they need to grow into the leaders they wish to become for themselves and their communities. Since its inception in 2006, Goal is now active in more than 20 countries around the world, and has reached more than 480,000 girls and young women.

In 2019, in line with the launching of Futuremakers by Standard Chartered, a Theory of Change has been developed. To track achievements and progress towards planned milestones and targets, Women Win has used different methods. Qualitative and quantitative data has been collected using surveys, periodic reports, most significant change tools, case studies etc. Data has been gathered and stored in Salesforce. Women Win has provided access to all Goal Implementing Partners (IPs) to Salesforce Community

Assignment

In an increasingly digital world, Women Win is considering how Goal implementing partners can use technology to collect data. One suggestion has been to examine how local partners can limit the collection of data through paper surveys and use mobile data collection applications to conduct this task.

Women Win is looking for a consultant to explore and test the digitisation of data collection tools. This process will likely include, but is not limited to: (1) discussion with Women Win to understand our needs and the required criteria of the chosen data collection applications, (2) calls with several Goal implementing partners, across key geographies, in order to ensure that the chosen application meets the varying needs on the ground, as well as to assess the potential constraints, (3) desk research and testing.

The **final output** of this work should include:

- 1 to 2-pager or deck with an overview of the research process
- Written recommendation of a digital data collection application

- Interest in and passion for girls and women's rights
