### ABOUT WOMEN WIN

Founded in 2007, [Women Win \(WW\)](#) is a global multi-dimensional women's fund guided by the vision of a future where every girl and woman\* exercises their rights. With a global team based largely in the Netherlands, WW collaborates with diverse partners to increase the assets, access, voice, and agency of women and girls around the world. Our programmatic work is distributed across three "Brands" which all serve WW's overall vision, but each with their own unique mission:

- **GRLS:** Advance the playing field that progresses gender equity in sport & through play;
- **Win-Win Strategies:** Connect the power of business with the deep assets of women's funds and organisations to economically empower women;
- **Ignita:** Champion innovative funding strategies that channel resources to local human & gender rights activists, organisations & movements.

Under the GRLS brand of work, the Leadership, Empowerment and Play (LEAP) Work Stream manages and supports a large global portfolio of implementing partners (IPs) to deliver girls' sports and rights programming with quality. Through LEAP, Women Win advances the playing field that empowers adolescent girls and young women to exercise their rights through sports and play. One of our key global initiatives within LEAP is the Goal Programme (Goal).

## Goal Programme

Goal is the flagship education programme within Futuremakers by Standard Chartered, the Bank's global initiative to tackle inequality and promote economic inclusion. The Goal programme uses sport, play and life-skills education to help tackle inequity and promote economic inclusion among girls ages 12-18 who live in underserved communities. Goal participants learn the skills they need to grow into the leaders they wish to become for themselves and their communities. Since its inception in 2006, Goal is now active in more than 20 countries worldwide and has reached more than 850,000 girls and young women.

Throughout the program's implementation, vast amounts of quantitative and qualitative data have been collected to measure and illustrate the program's impact. Qualitative and quantitative data have been collected using surveys, periodic reports, most significant change tools, case studies etc. and are stored and managed on Salesforce.

## Assignment

Women Win is looking for a consultant to analyse and explore the program's data to provide insights into the project impact beyond tracking milestones and targets, and facilitate in articulating the stories of change emanating from the program. This process will likely include but is not limited to (1) a discussion with Women Win to understand our monitoring and evaluation system and processes, (2) data mining from narrative reports and case studies shared by Goal implementing partners, program data and dashboards, pictures and videos etc, (3) data analysis and interpretation.

The final output of this work should include:

- A written report on key findings of the exercise.
- Insights of the program's keys data points and,
- Written recommendations on how best to present and share program data.
